

Korea House has been refurbished through a large-scale renovation and gone through historic events.

Now, it has turned into a high-end cultural complex aimed at preserving and promoting the beauty of Korean culture.



With Haeringwan Building built in traditional hanok style at the center, Korea House is composed of Chwiseongwan Building, a modern structure, and three annexes. It has not only a banquet room and separate rooms of various concepts and scales, but also a cafe, an art shop, and a parking lot, providing the best convenience.

the main structure of Korea House, serves as a reception hall of a hanok. It has a grand and graceful appearance that resembles a private house of an elite in the Joseon Dynasty. It is a perfect place for hosting luxurious MICE events as it has dining rooms of various scales and the Folk Theater.
